An introduction for parents and guardians

We know that not every student can sit high-stakes exams in a school or college setting at the end of their course. Life happens – and learning shouldn't stop because of it.

That's why we've created the **Pearson Remote Invigilation Service**. It's a flexible, student-first way to take **Pearson Edexcel International GCSEs** and

International A levels from home or another suitable location, all with the support and supervision of a live invigilator.

This introduction gives you a quick overview of the qualifications available through remote invigilation. It also answers key questions to help you decide whether this route is right for your child.

What technology is needed to use the service?

Your child will need access to:

- **Primary device:** A laptop or desktop with webcam, microphone, and stable internet.
- **Secondary device:** A mobile device with working camera, stable internet connection and the exam app downloaded.

- **Backup device:** A third device placed on airplane mode, positioned approximately 3 metres away to record the room throughout the exam.
- **Printer and scanner or scanning app:** This is essential for paper-based exams and our onscreen contingency process.



Is it a safe and secure process?



Yes, it is safe and secure.

The service includes:

- **Live invigilation:** Via webcam and microphone, ensuring real-time monitoring and guidance.
- **Safeguarding protocols:** Requiring a parent/guardian to be present at login and available during the exam setup and submission stages.
- **Private room requirement:** The exam room must be well-lit, quiet, and free from interruptions. Communal spaces are not permitted. All unauthorised items must be removed.

What technical support is available?



In the case of any technical issues, candidates are well supported by:

- **Technical support:** A dedicated student helpline is available during exams.
- **Backup device:** In the case of loss of internet candidates can continue offline but must remain visible to the backup device and contact the helpline for support submitting their responses.

How do you accommodate individual student needs?



The service can support individual needs through:

- **Accessibility functionality:** The assessment player allows candidates to adjust text size, text and background colour and other aspects of how the exam displays.
- **Access arrangements:** Rest breaks and extra time are supported for candidates with these approved access arrangements.
- **Personalised candidate support:** Our dedicated Student Support and Safeguarding Lead works with centres to understand specific candidate needs. Items such as noise cancelling headphones, fidget toys, and others can be accommodated.

Can students practise using the assessment player before their exams?



To ensure candidates are confident going into their exams, we provide:

- **Familiarisation sessions:** Mandatory practice runs help students feel confident navigating the platform.
- **Guidance materials:** Handbooks, video guides, and demo access are provided.
