



Pearson Remote Invigilation Service Instructions to Candidates

Pearson Edexcel January International AS and A level Examinations

Please read the following instructions carefully to ensure you take note of essential information ahead of your exams.

Your school or centre will provide you with login details to access your exams via the assessment player: <https://assessment.mod.pearson.com/login> .

Please test your login details before your first exam date, and check that all your exams appear under the “upcoming” tab. Contact your school or centre if there is anything you unsure of.

Standard January IAL Start Times

International A level (IAL) AM Exams start at 07:00am UK time

International A level (IAL) PM Exams start at 10:00am UK time

Please note all start times are published in UK GMT.

Standard start time exams will look like this on your assessment player – please refer to the information in the *yellow box* for the standard start time.

Start times are not optional. You are required to log in at the time related to your physical location which has been provided to us by your school/centre. Please consult your school if you are unsure which start time applies to you.

Please note: We are unable to adjust start times for candidates who travel or relocate post the late entry deadline.

Late arrivals: Please note that exams close 1 hour after the start time. You need to have logged in, completed the setup and **pressed start on your exam** before this period lapses. If you are late, you will not be admitted to the exam, as per Joint Council for Qualifications regulations.

Clashes: Please check with your school if you have any clashes and are unsure how these will be managed. It is the responsibility of the student and school to notify us about clashes.

Exam timetable and authorised materials: Please refer to the [Pearson Remote Invigilation Service International AS and A level Exams January 2026 Exam Timetable and Resources list](#) to check what you are allowed to bring into each exam and some additional important information about things to consider before, during and after your exam.

Your emergency contact details: If your emergency contact details have changed since your parent/guardian first signed the declaration, a new declaration should be submitted to your school with the latest information. Please request the form from your school if you do not have this.

Submitting your exam responses: For paper-based examinations via the Remote Invigilation Service, all answer pages must be compiled into a single pdf file before you upload it into the assessment player at the end of your exam. Please see the
